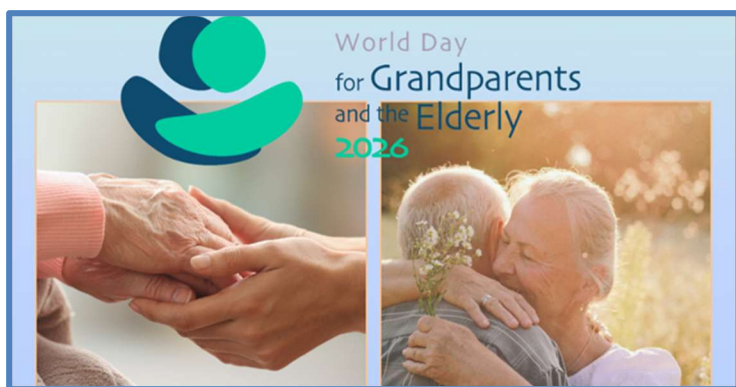
We look forward to celebrating Father Joseph and offering our prayers and best wishes for his continued ministry.
