ANNOUNCEMENTS

- › There will be no morning mass during the week of January 12th to the 16th.

OLA will start preparing candidates in January 2026 to receive the sacrament of Confirmation after Easter this spring.

Confirmation is the last Sacrament of Initiation and is required if someone wants to be a godparent or to be married in the Church.

- ⇒ Candidates must be 16 years of age in 2026
- ⇒ Adults who have not been confirmed are also encouraged to register
- ⇒ Adults must be baptized, if not, they should enroll in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, so they can be received into the Church at Easter
- ⇒ Candidates must provide their Baptismal Certificate

Who? Teens (must be 16 years old in 2026) and adults
What? Preparation for Confirmation, which will be celebrated probably in May 2026
When? January – April (2 sessions per month, 1½ hours per session)
 Dates/times to be determined.
Where? Our Lady of the Annunciation Parish Centre (189 Archambault St.)
How? Please register using the form at the hospitality table.
Cost? None, the parish provides materials.
